This petition is coming on before me for final hearing today in the presence of Sri Srikanth - representative of the appellant virtually and Sri Ravi Kumar - SAO/OP/Cyber City Circle for the respondents and having stood over for consideration, this Viduyut Ombudsman passed the following:

ORDER

This petition is registered suo-motu as per Clause 3.42 of Regulation 3 of 2015 of Hon'ble Telangana State Electricity Regulatory Commission for compliance of the Award passed in Appeal No. 06 of 2021-22 dt.29.10.2022 of this Authority, by the Licensee-respondents.

2. This Authority in the said Award has passed the following order:-

“In the result, the appeal is rejected, without costs, confirming the impugned Award passed by the learned Forum. However, a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) is awarded as compensation to the appellant by way of adjustment in the future bills of the appellant immediately. That amount is to be recovered from the officers/employees who were responsible for releasing the electricity supply to the residential building in spite of arrears due.”

3. Today Sri Ravi Kumar, SAO/OP/Cyber City Circle - Respondent No.3 has submitted the bill dt.01.10.2023 showing that an amount of Rs.25,000/-(Rupees twenty five thousand only) is credited to the account of the appellant. He also submitted that the amount of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) was recovered from the concerned officers/employees.

4. Heard both sides.

5. The point for consideration is, whether there are sufficient grounds to close the petition?

POINT

6. In view of the compliance of the Award passed by this Authority crediting an amount of Rs.25,000/-(Rupees twenty five thousand only) to the account of the appellant and in view of the recovery of the said amount from the

concerned officers/employees, the petition is liable to be closed.


RESULT

7. In the result, the petition is closed.
