This petition is coming on before me for final hearing today in the presence of Mr. Ravinder Prasad Srivatsava - authorised representative of the petitioner and Sri K. Vijay Kumar - ADE/OP/Charminar and Sri M. Ramana Murthy - AAO/ERO/Salarjung for the respondents and having stood over for consideration till today, this Vidhyut Ombudsman passed the following:

ORDER

This Authority in the Award dt.28.03.2023 in Appeal No. 38 of 2022-23 at para No.17 has passed the following order:-

“In view of the above discussions, the appeal is liable to be allowed. The Service Connections M1009269 and M2000068 in this case are exempted from payment of arrears of Service Connection No. M2004026. Accordingly, I hold that the appellant is not liable to pay the amount demanded by the respondents and the Award passed by the learned Forum is set aside.”

The appeal was accordingly allowed.

2. Further in the suo-motu petition, this Authority on 05.08.2023 has passed the following order:-

“In the result the petition is allowed in part and the respondents are directed to refund Rs.4,000/- to the appellant in Appeal No. 38 of 2022-23 by way of adjustment in the future electricity bill of the said appellant. The petition in respect of the balance amount is rejected. Call on 30.08.2023 for compliance.”

3. In the written replies filed by respondent No.3, it is stated that the amount has been credited to the Service Connection of the petitioner, which is also confirmed by the authorised representative of the petitioner.

4. Heard both sides.

5. The points for consideration are:-

i) Whether the petition is liable to be closed?

6. As seen from the record, as per the orders passed by this Authority in C.M.P.No. 20 of 2023-24 in Appeal No. 38 of 2022-23 dt.05.08.2023, the

respondents have credited the amount to the Service Connection of the petitioner/appellant and this is also confirmed by the authorised representative of the petitioner. In view of the compliance of the order, the petition is liable to closed.

RESULT

7. In the result the petition is closed.
